ONE NATION UNDER GOD

“Blessed is the nation who God is the LORD, and the people whom he has chosen for his own inheritance” (Psalm 33:12). Notice LORD is in small caps, because the writer substituted ADONAI (LORD) for God’s holy name, YAHWEH, or JEHOVAH in English. The Jewish people did not want in any way to do harm to the name of God by using it commonly, so they chose not to say it or write it. Even today Orthodox Jews write God as G-d. It’s not a typo, but again, the purpose is to avoid actually saying or writing the name of God, so as to keep it holy and not common. When speaking, they say, “HA SHEM,” which means *the Name*, referring to the Name of God. The point is: *Blessed is the nation whose God is the God of the Bible—JEHOVAH.*

The alternative is: *“The wicked*

shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God” (Psalm 9:17). In order to forget someone, you have to have known them and been acquainted with them. You had to have had some kind of relationship with them that you abandoned. You don’t actually forget they exist but, you have broken off your relationship, and that’s what it means here. God said that they forgot Him, and every nation; there are no exceptions, who forgets Him, shall be turned into Hell.

Some preachers say that because God has a covenant with America, He’s not going to judge America. Not according to Psalm 9:17. Before America was even thought of; before people knew this western hemisphere even existed, Israel, God’s chosen people forgot God, and He first split her into two nations: Israel & Judah,

and Israel went into exile to Babylon. Then 150 years later, Judah went into exile, and they have not had another king since then. What makes America think we will be the exception to Scripture?

THE FOUNDING FATHERS

Our nation was founded by great men who feared, respected, esteemed, and built its foundation upon the Bible, which is clearly echoed in her founding: Isaiah 33:22 states: “For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, and the LORD is our king.” From this they created the three branches of government of the United States: The judicial, the legislative, and the executive, which is equal to the President and his cabinet. They founded our nation upon the Word of God, but people today are saying that America was not founded on Christian principles, and even have redacted from our history books anything referring to God and our Christian foundation.

Anti-Christians claim that all they had in mind was to flee the oppression of taxes without representation under England’s King James. This is why America is a *republic*. People think we are a democracy, but we are not a democracy. We *believe in* democracy, but we are a *republic*, which is government by *representation*. We elect congressmen and senators to represent us in Washington and to vote on our behalf. The claim is that

they came to America to get out from under the oppression of taxation without representation, and not to escape religious oppression. But America’s birth certificate is the *Mayflower Compact* by the Puritans. They sailed the Atlantic, enduring a terrible journey on its frigid oceanic waters. And while they were on board, before they had landed their feet on American soil, they drew up this covenant:

“In the name of God, Amen. We whose names are underwritten, the loyal subjects of our dread sovereign, Lord King James, by the grace of God, of Great Britain, France, Ireland, defender of the faith. Having undertaken, for the glory of God, and advancement of the Christian faith, and honor of our king and country, a voyage to plant the first colony in the Northern parts of Virginia, do by these present, solemnly and mutually in the presence of God, and of one another, covenant and combine ourselves together into a civil body politic; for our better ordering and preservation and furtherance of the ends aforesaid...”

When they came to start this nation, they were not thinking about taxes and representation; they came for the glory of God and the advancement of the Christian faith!

Our Founding Fathers, who declared America’s independence from Britain, wrote the *Declaration of Independence*, and some later had a part in crafting the *Constitution* and

Bill of Rights. Following are some of their memorable quotes:

Patrick Henry: *“I repeat it, Sir, we must fight; an appeal to arms and the God of Hosts is all that is left us! Sir, we are not weak, if we make a proper use of those means which the God of nature hath placed in our power.... Besides, Sir, we shall not fight our battles all alone. There is a just God who presides over the destinies of nations, and who will raise up friends to fight our battles for us (and God raised up France)... Is life so dear, or peace so sweet, as to be purchased at the price of chains and slavery? Forbid it, Almighty God! I know not what course others may take, but as for me, give me liberty, or give me death!”*

It would be a decade before they put the Constitution into place, and it did not come easily. One of its most brilliant writers was **Benjamin Franklin** who was the aged statesman among those who were joined together in a sweltering hot room in Philadelphia in the middle of summer. Imagine, with no air conditioning, roasting under the long white wigs on their heads, and high ruffled collars on their necks, with long pants and stockings underneath, they labored, getting nowhere. Finally, now an elderly man, Benjamin Franklin stood up and said:

“I have lived, Sir, a long time, and the longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth, that God governs in the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to

the ground without His notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without His aid? We have been assured in the sacred writings, that ‘except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it.’ I firmly believe this, and I also believe that without His concurring aid, we shall succeed in this political building no better than the builders of Babel.”

They were at an impasse, and at his words, they stopped their disputations to ask God for His aid, because they did not want to build another Babel. They needed the blessing of God, the direction, and wisdom of God, and after that speech, they got down on their knees to pray, and when they had finished, they went back to work and wrote the Constitution, the greatest document of freedom in the world.

Regarding the Constitution, **John Adams**, our second president, said:

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*“We have no government armed with power, capable of contending with human passions unbridled by morality and religion. **Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people.** It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”*

He meant that this Constitution will not work in a nation unless its people are godly and moral. It was written for godly people; that’s why today *ungodly people* want to interpret it another way or to change it, because the Constitution is based on the premise that it is for a nation of godly people with biblical principles.

THE SUPREME COURT

We certainly are hearing much about SCOTUS these days, but let’s see what its first Chief Justice, **John Jay**, said. By the way, he simultaneously served as the president of the *American Bible Society*. I don’t think that could happen today, do you? I don’t think we have a Congress and Senate who would approve him. John Jay said:

*“The Bible is the best of all books; for it is the Word of God and teaches us the way to be happy in this world and in the next. Continue therefore to read it and to regulate your life by its precepts. Providence has given to our people the choicest of their rulers, and it is the duty, as well as the privilege and interest of our **Christian nation**, to select and prefer **Christians** for their rulers.”* This

man would be tarred and feathered today if he said this! *Prefer Christian rulers?—Are you kidding me?*

James Wilson was an original justice on the Supreme Court when John Jay was the Chief Justice. He said: *“Human law must rest its authority upon the authority of that law which is Divine (the Bible). Far from being rivals or enemies, religion and law are twin sisters, and mutual assistants. Indeed, these two sciences run into each other.”* I don’t think he’d make it on the Supreme Court today either, do you?

GEORGE WASHINGTON

When he laid his hand on the Bible to swear his oath of office as President of the United States, he said: *“It is impossible to rightly govern the world without God and the Bible.”*

In his first inaugural speech he said: *“It would be peculiarly improper of me to omit, in this my first official act, my fervent supplication to that Almighty Being who rules over the universe, and who presides in the counsel of nations.”* He said God not only rules over the universe, and governs the moon, the stars, the planets, day and night, the seasons and all scientific laws, but He presides in the counsels, the advisements, and governing laws of nations. He said: *“It is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey His will, to be grateful for His benefits, and humbly implore His*

protection and favor.”

In one of his prayers he said, “*Bless, O Lord, the whole race of mankind, and let the world be filled with the knowledge of Thee, and of Thy Son Jesus Christ.*”

THE WARNERS

Perhaps because they saw the tyranny in Europe that they had escaped, in many of their speeches there is a strong warning to those who would forget God and abandon our Christian foundation.

Thomas Jefferson, our third president, had a large part in the writing of the *Declaration of Independence*. Some think that he also had a part in writing the *Constitution*, but this is a huge misunderstanding that keeps being repeated erroneously. While the *Constitution* was being written in that hot, stuffy room in Philadelphia, Thomas Jefferson was in France. Yet, the claim is that he intended there to be *a separation of church and state* in the First Amendment. He wasn’t even in the room! In response to a *private letter* he received from ministers in New England, he used the phrase *separation of church and state*. They were concerned that like in England, they could be forced to come under a state religion, for which tyranny their forbears had left England. He replied that the government could not force a religion on them, could not take away their freedom of religion, because the *Constitution* insures a

separation of church. But today, people have flipped it to mean that the government must strip you of your religious freedom in political matters.

One of his impassioned speeches: “*And can the liberties of a nation be thought secure when we have removed their only firm basis, a conviction in the minds of the people that these liberties are the gift of God? That they are not to be violated but with His wrath? Indeed, I tremble for my country when I reflect that God is just; that His justice cannot sleep forever.*” How can we not incur the wrath of God with what evil we seeing today in this nation?

Jedediah Morse was the first to publish a textbook of the geography of America in 1874, and his books became the standard textbooks in American public schools. (His son Samuel Morse, was the inventor of the Morse code.)

Jedediah said: “*To the kindly influence of Christianity we owe that degree of civil freedom, and political and social happiness, which mankind now enjoys. Whenever the pillars of Christianity shall be overthrown, and our present republican forms of government, and all blessings which flow from them, must fall with them.*”

If you remove the pillars of Christianity, our nation will fall, such as the pillar of marriage in **Genesis 2:24**, which Jesus repeated in **Matthew 19:5** and Paul in **Ephesians 5:31** These include the pillars of *heterosexuality* and

monogamy. When you start removing pillars, the roof is going to cave in, and the foundation will crumble: “*If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?*” (Psalm 11:3).

“*Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people*” (Pro.14:34). No matter how glorious the foundation, how mighty the military, how prosperous the people, how resourceful a land is, God’s Word says, “*Sin is a reproach!*” We read that the nation that forgets God will be turned into hell, and we are leaving the foundation this great nation was built upon, turning our backs on God and His laws, and the results will be catastrophic.

GOD IS NOT ALLOWED HERE

Another great Founding Father, **Noah Webster**, said: “*The moral principles and precepts contained in the Scriptures ought to form the basis of all our civil constitutions and laws. All miseries and evils that men suffer from, vice crime, ambition, injustice, oppression, slavery, and war proceed from their despising or neglecting the precepts contained in the Bible.*”

Our public schools no longer teach our children God’s laws. Since 1962-63, when we removed prayer and Bible reading, we no longer teach the foundational truths of morality from the Word of God. When I was in school, every morning we started with the Lord’s Prayer, one of the Psalms, and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Some of the psalms I

learned in early childhood, I didn’t learn from reading the Bible or Sunday School or sitting in church, but by reciting them every morning in public school. For instance, **Psalm 100:**

“*Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all you lands. Serve the Lord with gladness. Come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD He is God: It is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves. We are his people and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise; be thankful and bless his holy name. For the Lord is good, and his mercy is everlasting, and his truth endureth to all generations.*”

I learned in Elementary School Number 33, in South Baltimore: *It is God who has made us, and not we ourselves.* By reading this simple psalm, we understand we were not created by evolution! Even the *Declaration of Independence* states that we have *certain inalienable rights we received from our Creator, and that all men are created equally.* But we are failing to teach our children this and have removed all knowledge of God from Bible reading and prayer. There has been a call to remove the Pledge of Allegiance, because of the part “*One nation under God.*” Some say it violates their conscience and offends them. I guess it does, because their consciences are defiled. Other groups are saying they’re not going fly the American flag, the red white and

blue, but the *rainbow* flag, the symbol for gays, is okay. Some are bold enough to fly the Hamas flag! But the American flag? It's too offensive.

And our nation is filled with perversion, homo and transgender sexuality, child prostitution, Satanism, violence and gangs, and abortion, because we never taught the last few generations the Lord is our God, and He has made us and created us in His image and in His likeness. We've taken away these truths from our children. The Ten Commandments, the bedrock of human morality, is banned from many public places. Yet, a group of Satan worshippers once erected an eleven-foot bronze statue of a horned goat upon a throne, representing Satan, in the city of Detroit.

There is a strong correlation between America and Israel. I say this because there are only two nations on the face of the earth that God specifically created for His glory and honor, and to propagate His Word to the nations, and that is Israel and America, as we saw in the Mayflower Compact.

"For what nation is there so great who has God so nigh unto them, as the Lord our God is in all that things that we call upon him for? And what nation is there so great that has statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law which I set before you this day? Only take heed to yourself, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things which your eyes

have seen, and unless they depart from your heart all the days of your life; but teach them to your sons and your sons' sons" (Deut. 4:7-9).

We can easily insert "America" here, because what nation is there, as we have read in the words of our Founding Fathers, like unto our nation that was given such laws of righteousness, biblical principles, and teachings of Christianity? Likewise, we too must heed the warning, lest we forget, for we know the consequences for a nation that forgets God! We should learn from Israel's example what not to do!

Right before the nation went into exile to Babylon, and their kings stripped from the throne, the prophet Isaiah declared: *"Hear O heavens, and give ear, O earth: for the LORD has spoken, I have nourished and brought up children, and they have rebelled against me..."* There's nothing so painful as to raise children and invest your time, your love, your wisdom, your understanding, yourself into them, for them to grow up and rebel. It breaks your heart like nothing else can. The other side of this is what John said: *"I have no greater joy than to know my children walk in truth"* (3John 4). The greatest joy is to know our children are walking in truth, and the greatest heartache is to see them rebel against the truth.

"The ox knows his owner, and the ass [donkey] knows his master's crib [where he gets his food], but Israel does not know. My people do not

consider. Ah, sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters, they have forsaken the LORD, they provoked the Holy One of Israel to anger; they are gone away backward” (Isa.1:2-4).

God’s lament: “I have nourished them; I have brought them up, pouring out abundant blessings upon them, and instead of their being appreciative and grateful for My graciousness, they have rebelled against Me. Look at the ox and ass—the dumbest animals, and stubborn too, but they know their masters! They know who feeds them; who provides all things for them. But not My people; not My children—they don’t know Me! They have forgotten Me and have rebelled against Me and were willfully ignorant.

THE LAW OF INIQUITY

While sin is a specific act and breach of God’s laws, *the law of iniquity* is a bent towards evil, the tendency to be sinful, and the problem is, it is not static, but increases with every generation. According to Jer.7:26, 16:12, 30:14, Sin gets worse with every generation, and they become more iniquitous: “*They proceed from evil to evil*” (Jer.9:3). Paul said, “*Evil workers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived*” (2Tim.3:13). It boils down to: Sinful parents bear sinful children, and they will go deeper into sin than their parents did and into greater depravity

than the generation before. And if we think this generation is depraved, what will the next generation be who will grow up from day one with same-sex marriage? By then what will marriage have become? Not just two men or two women, but polygamists also want their rights to marry. Then there are the abominable pedophiles, men who have strong urges for little boys. They say that just like the homosexuals, they cannot help themselves; that they are made that way. What will the next generations be like for our children and grandchildren! They will have no reference point of what a biblical godly marriage is.

A CITY SET ON A HILL

Israel was created to be “*a light to the Gentiles*” (Isa 49:6), but their light went out, and they went into exile and slavery to the kings of Babylon. God raised America up to be a light to the nations, and for over two hundred years, we have sent missionaries to the four corners of the earth with the Gospel, fulfilling what Jesus said: “*You are the salt of the earth, but if the salt has lost its savor (taste), wherewith shall it be salted? It is henceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden underfoot of men. You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it gives light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before*

men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father which is in heaven” (Matt.5:14-16)

A city set on a hill cannot be hid! The city of Jerusalem rests upon four mountains including Mt. Zion. Whenever you speak of going to Jerusalem, it is always said that *you go up to Jerusalem and up to God’s house*. In the literal sense, Jerusalem is on a hill. In a metaphoric sense, *Washington DC*, our nation’s capital, *is a city set on a hill!* I’m not referring to topography, but in a real sense to the rest of the world, it’s a city set on a hill.

For instance, when watching the network news, and a reporter is standing with the Capitol building in the background, they conclude their report by saying *“This is John Doe reporting from Capitol Hill.”* Sometimes reporters shorten it to *“Up on the hill today...”* When somebody says *up on the hill*, we immediately know they’re talking about *Capitol Hill* in *Washington DC*, the seat of our federal government where the houses of Congress and Senate meet to legislate the laws of our land. *Washington DC* is the highest seat of government on the planet, the emblem of liberty and freedom, and the ideal of human government for the whole world. Decisions that are made *up on the hill* in *Washington* have far-reaching powers and influence. It truly is *a city that is set on a hill*, and Jesus said that a city set on a hill cannot be hid!

If we examine the actual physical structures and buildings and monuments in *Washington*, we will quickly see that the United States was built upon a Christian foundation, and the voices of those who built this nation are still speaking, because their words are literally etched and engraved upon the marble walls and buildings and monuments of *Washington DC*

THE CAPITOL

When the Capitol was being built, the first cornerstone was laid by George Washington. Then **Daniel Webster** who was the secretary of state, inserted a box containing significant documents about the nation’s founding. He said, *“To all here assembled, whether belonging to public or to private life, with happy hearts devoutly thankful to Almighty God for the presence of the liberty and happiness of our country, unite in sincere and fervent prayer that the deposit in the walls and arches, the domes and towers, the columns and entablatures now to be erected over it, may endure forever. God save the United States of America.”* Because a city set on a hill cannot be hid!

Inside of the rotunda hang beautiful oil paintings, some of our Founding Fathers signing documents, and in most every painting, there is an overture to God: Whether they have a Bible in their hands, a Bible sitting on the desk, whether kneeling to pray, or lifting

up hands in prayer, they are the Christian men who founded America. Throughout the Capitol there are many scriptural references on its walls. One of the most iconic is engraved in the marble wall above the head of the Speaker of the House, who sits behind the podium in the house of Congress: **“In God We Trust!”** If anti-God zealots want to get rid of it, they will have to sandblast it!

THE WHITE HOUSE

The White House is another icon of freedom to the whole world. In one bedroom, above the fireplace, put there by **John Adams**, the first president to reside in the White House, are these words: *“I pray Heaven to bestow the best of blessings upon this White House and upon all that shall hereafter inhabit it.”* He was praying to the God of the Bible, from the White House of the American people, from the City set on a hill that cannot be hid!

THE SUPREME COURT

Every session of the Supreme Court is opened with these words: *“O yea, O yea, O yea, all persons here assembled and having business before the honorable Supreme Court of the United States are admonished to draw near and give their attention. For the court is now sitting. God save the United States and the honorable Supreme Court.”* This petition is becoming even more necessary considering how they are

voting God’s laws out of America.

THE WASHINGTON MONUMENT

The Washington Monument rises 555 feet in the air and was built to commemorate our first president, George Washington. Once inside, were you allowed to climb to the top, you would see Scriptures engraved on the walls, such as John 5:39: *“Search the scriptures, for in them you shall find eternal life, and they are they that testify of me”* (Jesus). Another: *“Holiness unto the Lord”* (Ex.28:36). Jesus said: *“Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not, for of such is the kingdom of heaven”* (Mt.19:14). *“Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it”* (Pro.22:6). Again you would see our national motto: *“In God we trust.”* The very top is capped with a golden dome and the inscription: *“Praise be to God!”*

THE LIBRARY OF CONGRESS

Its walls are also engraved with Scriptures, such as Psalm 19:1: *“The heavens declare the glory of God, and the earth shows forth his handiwork.”* Also, one of my favorites, Micah 6:8: *“Thou know, O man, what does the Lord require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God.”*

There you can look up the inaugural speeches of all the presidents, from George Washington to our time, and you would find in

every one a reference to Almighty God. Everyone who takes the office of President, on his inaugural day, puts his hand on the Bible and swears the Presidential oath, saying, “*So help me, God.*” We know which God they’re talking about—the LORD God—the God of the Bible!

You can also read the Constitutions of all 50 states, and in each there is a reference to Almighty God. Every state, nationwide, was founded on Christianity. New York’s says: “*We the people of New York, grateful to Almighty God for our freedom, in order to procure His blessings, do establish this Constitution.*” And may I say, New York City is also a city set on a hill that cannot be hid, because it is where the United Nations convenes, and the eyes of the world are upon it.

THE CIVIL WAR

The darkest time in our nation’s history was the Civil War when the nation was divided because of the evil sin of slavery. At its end, President Abraham Lincoln issued the *Proclamation of Emancipation* which demanded all slaves in the United States of America be set free, but it came at a heavy cost. Within months of his inauguration, several Southern States seceded from the nation. The division spread, and others followed, starting their own country, the Confederate States of America. I don’t know if Abraham Lincoln thought this would happen, but when it did, he knew it was not

God’s will for the country to be divided, and for the South to become a slave nation. It left him no choice but to go to war, and what a terrible war it was! Families in the South who had relatives in the North, were fighting each other, killing each other. It decimated the South, pretty much burned it down. Those who died in the Civil War are more than all those who have died in all the wars America has been in since.

It was a dark time, but it had to be. God had prospered America for over 100 years, and the nation blossomed into the greatest nation on the earth, but God could not let her continue until she dealt with her sin of slavery. After the Civil War, growth and enterprise took off like crazy. Americans invented the telephone, the Morse code, the automobile, the airplane, and new machinery. The Industrial Revolution was born after America dealt with her sin of slavery. But in those earlier dark days, Abraham Lincoln said,

“We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties of Heaven. We have been preserved these many years in peace and prosperity. We have grown in numbers, and wealth, and power, as no other nation has ever grown. But we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace, and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us; and we have vainly imagined in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom

and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the God that made us! It behooves us then to humble ourselves before the offended Power to confess our national sins, and to pray for clemency and forgiveness.”

God forgave America for her sin of slavery, but at a terrible cost. It was a long time before the country was truly united, and we still deal with some of the aftermath to this day. But let it be known, that when a nation humbles herself and prays; when its leaders go to Washington and publicly confess our sins, God will forgive and bless the nation. We have come to another dark time in our nation when it's just as evil, and Saints, we the Church must stand up for righteousness. The world will do what the world does. Jesus said, *“Let filthy be filthy still, but let the righteous be righteous still, and let the holy be holy still”* (Rev.22:11). We are the ones who must stand up against evil, and pray and repent on behalf of our nation.

A closing quote from **Martin Luther King, JR**, the champion of civil rights in our lifetime, who was responsible for tearing down many of the walls of segregation that remained in the South and across this nation, separating whites from blacks in public places, restaurants, bus stations etc. We have heard his impassioned speech *“I Have a*

Dream,” but I want you to hear these words he spoke to our nation: *“I still believe that standing up for the truth of God is the greatest thing in the world. The end of life is to do the will of God, come what may.”* Come what may!

This is why he stood the way he did, and he paid the price, knowing he faced the real possibility of being assassinated. But that didn't stop him, because God raised him up in his day and his hour, and gave him a platform and a voice that everybody heard. It could cost him his life, but he stood firm in his mission.

The question is, Do we still believe the truth of the Bible is worth standing for? Whether it's in the workplace or the pulpit, we need to be bold for the truth and our religious right to express them. And let me say, you can pray for me extra and more, because preachers are on Satan's hit list! Preachers who preach against evil are a big target for those who hate the Bible's message of righteousness. We are the voices crying in the wilderness of sin to repent and prepare the way of the Lord. We have received the baton from those who founded the liberties and freedoms we have and those who put their lives on the line to preserve them.

The Word of the Lord is speaking: *“Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity?”* (Psalm 94:16). Come what may!

THE HANDWRITING ON THE WALL!



AMERICA: WEIGHED IN THE BALANCE

In Bible days all scales and weights had to be calibrated to the temple standard. Corrupt men had two sets of weights in their bags, creating a double standard.
